They also need plastic bags — regular and the larger, heavier ones. Thank you in advance for your help. Also, more volunteers are needed — with attendance at that number, the volunteers were kept moving.

### **DOLLAR FOR MISSIONS UPDATE:--**

The current project is to replace furnaces at Immanuel Lutheran Student Center, Macomb: Immanuel Lutheran Student Center, at Western Illinois University in Macomb, celebrated its 50th anniversary some five years ago. Now furnaces need to be replaced. The current Dollar for Missions project is to provide \$25,000 for furnace replacement to keep the student center both operational and operating for years into the future. District reports that about 40% of the total amount has been collected.
